## Little Bedwyn & Chisbury Parish Council meeting Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> May at 8pm St Michael's Church

## 2. Matters arising:

- 2.1 **Road safety**: Cllr Ball will contact Wiltshire Council to explore options for improving visibility and road safety at the junction of the road heading north from Chisbury and the A4.
- 2.2 Councillors discussed the state of the local roads, and specifically potholes. They noted that the large pothole close to the junction of Brown's Lane and the northward road to Chisbury had been partly filled in (since being reported to Wiltshire Council), but also noted that this part of the road has been repeatedly patched up over the past couple of years but that the pothole typically reappears within months. They also noted that other potholes in the parish that have recently been semi-filled in have already reopened.
